## Welcome to Math 8

This class will give you the strong foundation that you will need in order to succeed in high school math. It will also help you to better use mathematics in your everyday life. It's my goal to make learning fun and maybe by the end of the school year you'll love math as much as I do! I'm looking forward to an exciting year of learning with you!

Supplies: I expect you to be prepared every day with the following:
$\checkmark$ A pencil with eraser (because we ALL make mistakes!)
$\checkmark$ Texas Instruments Scientific Calculator Model TI-30X IIS
$\checkmark$ One-inch binder (or $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch binder) with loose-leaf paper \& graph paper - Please do NOT share this binder with any other subjects if possible.

- You will keep classwork and homework together in the same section and in date order.
$\checkmark$ Loose leaf paper and graph paper must be in your binder at all times.
$\checkmark 4$ folders to keep at home: Each quarter you will empty your binder into one of these folders. This will help you to keep your notes organized and in a safe place.

Classroom Rules: The rules are simple (the 5 P's):

$\checkmark$ Be Punctual.
$\checkmark$ Be Prepared with your homework and the supplies listed above.
$\checkmark$ Be Polite. Raise your hand if you want to speak and be a listener when your teacher or a classmate is talking.
$\checkmark$ Be a Participant. Always give your best effort and don't be afraid to make mistakes!
$\checkmark$ Perform the directions the first time they are given.

## Classroom Procedures:

1. Take your seat as soon as you walk into the room.
2. Take out your homework from the night before.
3. Copy down your homework assignment.
4. Start the warm up activity right away.
5. Class ends when I dismiss you. Please wait for me to give the O.K. before you begin to pack up.

## If you are absent:

You are responsible for ALL notes, classwork and homework you missed that day.

- It's also a good idea to have the phone number of at least two classmates.
- You can also check my website to find out the topic that was taught, and dates of any upcoming quizzes or tests. It's updated by the end of each school day.
- When you return, make sure to copy the notes you missed from a classmate and pick up any worksheets you missed from the bin. It's also a good idea to attend extra help to get yourself caught up.
- *If you miss a test, be prepared to take it on the day you return or at the next available extra help session. If you were absent for more than just the day of the test, speak to me about a make-up date.

## Grading Policy:

Tests and Quizzes count as $85 \%$ of your grade.
Homework counts as $15 \%$ of your grade.
Test \& Quiz Grade (85\% of your grade): I use the percent proportion to determine this grade.
For example, determine this student's $1^{\text {st }}$ quarter test and quiz average by using the percent proportion.

$\frac{\text { Total Points Earned }}{\text { Total Points Possible }}=\frac{\%}{100}$
For example:
$\frac{463}{500}=\frac{x}{100}$
$500 x=46300$
$x=92.6$
$x \approx 93 \%$

Homework Grade (15\% of your grade): Each homework assignment is worth 5 points. If you miss a homework assignment it can be made up the next day for partial credit (you will lose 3 points for lateness). Homework will NOT be accepted any later than the day after it's due (unless you were absent for more than one day). Homework will be checked every day and might be collected randomly during the week.

You will have homework just about every night. In math the most important thing you can do is practice! Homework will be graded on EFFORT and COMPLETENESS.
$>$ To earn full credit it is important that you:
$\checkmark$ Try EVERY problem.
$\checkmark$ Show ALL work for each problem.
$\checkmark$ Show ALL attempts at problems you couldn't solve.
$\checkmark$ DON'T leave any questions completely blank.
